This session will also propose GESI considerations that can be considered in urban and transport planning projects to increase awareness of GESI and make a positive impact towards championing GESI initiatives.

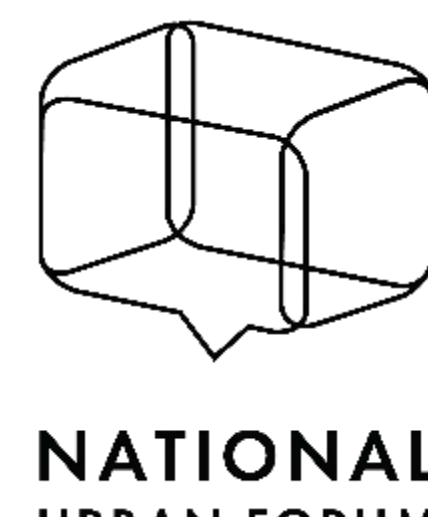

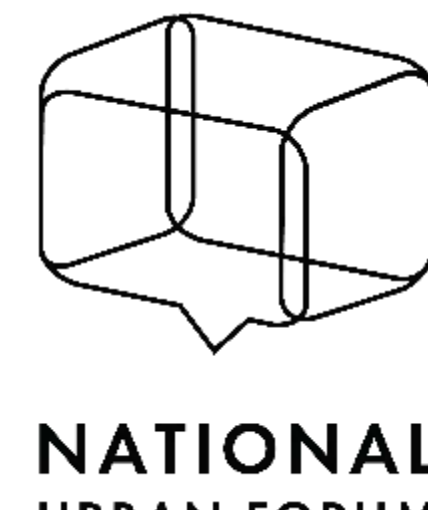
